The meeting will be at the Supervisor of Elections Office located at the Highlands County Government Center, 580 South Commerce Ave., Room A201, Sebring, Florida. If a recess is needed during this meeting, it will be announced at the meeting.

The entire canvassing board / audit procedure is open to the public and may be viewed by the public in the front lobby of the Supervisor of Elections Office in Room A201 at the Highlands County Government Center.
