Occupational License

Persons or firms engaged in occupations, professions, businesses and classifications are required to purchase an occupational license to open a business within the town limits.



Do I have to be approved for a license?

The Town License Official and Town Clerk have the right to approve occupational licenses. And the Town Council has the right to revoke any licenses issued within its limits.



If I have just a small business, do I still have to purchase a license?

The fact that any person, firm or corporation reporting itself or himself and is engaged in any profession or occupation for the transaction of business by exhibiting a sign or advertisement or otherwise indicating engagement is required to have a license.

Any person, firm or corporation that shall carry on or conduct any business, profession, occupation or industry for which a license is required without first obtaining a license shall be fined not exceeding \$500.00.



How much does a license cost?

An occupational license only costs \$30.00 per business.



How long is the license valid?

The occupational license is valid for one fiscal year (October 1st to September 30). No license shall be issued for more than one fiscal year.



Can I transfer my license?

If there is no name change within the business the license can be transferred for only \$3.00.
